CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. The sale will be held under BTSS rules & regulations
2. An inspector will inspect all sheep prior to the show & sale. Any lot which fails to meet the rules & regulations as are particular to this show & sale will be disqualified and must be with-drawn and removed from the premises forthwith.
3. Particular attention is drawn to the rule stating that all sheep must be shown in natural state, i.e no trimming, no brushing or washing of wool. Excessively dipped sheep will not be accepted.
4. All females must be barren at the time of sale unless otherwise stated. Any ewe declared as 'run with ram' and/or 'believed in lamb' must be in lamb to a Registered Dutch Texel ram.
5. Any ram sold to be capable of and effective at natural service. If any ram is proved to be incapable of or ineffective service **written** notice to that effect, **supported by a Veterinary Surgeon certificate**, must be given by the purchaser to the auctioneers **within 12 (twelve) weeks after the date of sale**. The purchaser may then return the ram to the vendor who shall, at the purchaser's option, replace the ram with another ram of equal value, capable of stock getting, or refund the purchase price of the animal together with any reasonable cost of each way haulage, keep and veterinary fees for the required certificate. Rigs will not be accepted.
6. All sheep will be sold in guineas with an upset price of **120gns** on shearling rams, and **100gns** on ram lambs and shearling ewes. Any sheep failing to meet this minimum price will be passed from the sale ring.
7. Commission will be charged at 5p in the guinea, plus 0.5% BTSS levy.
8. An entry fee of £9 is payable (nonrefundable).
9. Vendors wishing to present stock for the show & sale must ensure that these sheep are in the market from 7 – 9am and that they have been passed by the inspection panel and/or veterinary surgeon before penning.
10. The decision of the inspector an/or veterinary surgeon will be final and binding.
11. All prize winners must be sold through the ring otherwise prizes will be withheld.
12. All sheep with bad tattoo marks must be tagged with the correct number.
13. No stock may be removed without either a receipted account or an authorized pass and the identity tag with each sheep must be given to the market staff before stock is loaded.
14. The Auctioneers accept no liability in respect of any claim whatsoever arising howsoever. The descriptions are supplied by the vendors who are wholly responsible for details and accuracy. The Auctioneers will not be answerable for any errors which may occur in the catalogue.
15. Any dispute over warranties/pedigrees or such matter which are not specifically dealt with in the conditions of sale will be settled in accordance with the rules of the BTSS, whose decision will be final and binding on all parties.
16. All sheep must be MV accredited. MV forms must be handed to the stewards before unloading.
17. Sheep will be sold in catalogue order, except for the Champion, which will be sold at the discretion of the auctioneers and vendor.
18. The Auctioneers General Condition of Sale apply.
19. All private sales must be booked through the Auctioneers.
20. The sale is conducted under DEFFRA Rules & Regulations relevant on the day of sale.
21. Any animal with an inspection declaration mark is **NOT** eligible for the show classes.

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All sheep entered into the sale have been entered by the vendor on the basis that they are a minimum of 15/16th Dutch or Belgian Texel bloodlines. The responsibility for the accuracy rests solely with the vendor and not with The Dutch Texel Producer Group, The BTSS or Ruthin Farmers Auction Co Ltd.

All sheep to be birth notified or registered with the British Texel Sheep Society.
